Suicide Risk Assessment Quick Reference



- ⇒ ASK "S" Question
- \Rightarrow Current Plan/Access to Means
- ⇒ Past Suicidal Behaviors or Attempts
 - Self Harm Behavior
- \Rightarrow Risky Behaviors
 - Substance Use or Abuse
 - ⇒ Anger
 - Ambivalence Life vs. Death
 - Access to Safety Net

Suicide risk factors that may increase rate:

- Mental Health Disorder Diagnosis
- Family History Mental Health/Substance Abuse/Suicide
- Drastic Changes
- Stressful Live Events
- Helpless/Hopeless
- Bullying/Isolation/Burdensomeness
- LGBTQ
- Chronic/Terminal Illness
